

# ROCKY MOUNTAIN RELOCATION COUNCIL

## 2019 Scholarship Application Guidelines

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The Rocky Mountain Relocation Council (RMRC) is a non-profit organization that brings together corporations and relocation service providers in and around Denver for the primary purpose of providing educational information and current industry updates to its members. RMRC has developed an annual scholarship program for current high school seniors who have relocated into the Greater Denver Metropolitan Area during grades 9 through 12. **The one-time award of \$1,500 for each scholarship will be presented to two area high school seniors in the spring of 2018.** The award will be sent to the college (2-year or 4-year) or university that the student will be attending to assist with tuition or any other applicable expenses.

RMRC will select a scholarship winner based on the strength of the eligible applicant's total completed application that includes academic performance, extra-curricular activities and an essay addressing the impact of relocating to a new area and new high school and the way the applicant handled the many challenges and opportunities associated with the relocation. Within the essay, the student should also provide advice to other teenagers preparing to relocate.

**Eligible** applicants must meet these requirements:

- Currently a senior in good standing in a greater Denver metropolitan area high school
- Relocated during grades 9 through 12
- Relocated a distance greater than 50 miles and changed schools due to this relocation
- A cumulative minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a scale of 4.0 (or equivalent achievement on a different scale)

**Applications must be postmarked or date stamped no later than April 1, 2019.** The scholarship will be presented at the RMRC Spring conference on **April 24, 2019.**

**Please submit the following information along with your application to your Guidance Department for verification:**

1. Please list (on a separate sheet) all your extra-curricular activities and work experience during high school grades 9 through 12).
2. Please submit an original essay (must not be less than 1,000 words or greater than 1,500 words) addressing the following:

Your experiences associated with your relocation into the Greater Denver Metropolitan Area. Please feel free to describe your family background, challenges encountered with the relocation, and successes achieved. We would also appreciate any advice you would give to another teenager preparing to relocate (as you did)!

The scholarship winner will be asked to present the essay in person at the RMRC Spring conference.
